

# Kennet & Avon Canal

Gliding for 86 miles from the Thames to the Floating Harbour in Bristol, the Kennet & Avon is arguably one of the most picturesque waterways in Britain.

Bath's Georgian splendour, Berkshire and Wiltshire's rolling hills. It's a pretty special combination. The waterway itself is rather special too, with unique architectural and engineering features crafted by John Rennie, like turf-sided locks and aqueducts and bridges. This is a route with abundant flora and fauna, like pied wagtails, flowering rushes and dragonflies. Beyond Hanham Lock, the Avon is tidal and takes you on to Bristol for theatres, shops and restaurants.
